

- DAY 01 THURS 18 OCT** **JOHANNESBURG / CAIRO**
We meet at O.R. Tambo International Airport 3 hours prior to departure, complete the necessary formalities and depart on Egypt Air Flight MS 840 at 21:45 on our overnight flight to Cairo. Dinner onboard.
- DAY 02 FRI 19 OCT** **CAIRO / BEN GURION – MT CARMEL – NAZARETH – CANA – TIBERIAS**
Arrive in Cairo at 06:30. We remain in transit and proceed to the Air Sinai check in counters for our flight to Ben Gurion. We depart on flight 4D at ... and arrive in Tel Aviv at ± 11:30 am. Continue to Mt. Carmel and visit the site where Elijah had the confrontation with the Baal prophets (1 Kings 2 v15). Continue to Nazareth where we will have a short orientation tour of Nazareth by bus. Visit the Church of Annunciation, located above the spring which supplied water for Mary's Well. We continue via Cana in Galilee, the site where Jesus performed his first miracle. Drive to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 03 SAT 20 OCT** **FULL DAY GALILEE + BOAT – YARDINITE**
This morning you'll cross the Sea of Galilee by boat to Capernaum to see the ruins of a 2nd century synagogue, which also features an extremely well preserved oil press. See the mountain of Beatitudes where the Sermon of the Mount (Matt 5-7) was delivered and Tabgha the traditional site where the multiplication of the loaves and fishes were performed (Mark 6:32-44). Right on the shore of the Lake is the Chapel of Mensa Christi, site of the re-commissioning of Peter (Jn. 21). Our last stop for the day is Yardenite where the Jordan River flows from the Sea of Galilee. This spot marks the traditional place where John the Baptist baptized Jesus, and was developed as a baptismal area. Dinner and overnight.
- DAY 04 SUN 21 OCT** **TIBERIAS – BET SHEAN – JERICHO* – QUMRAN – EIN BOKEK**
After breakfast we depart, and our first visit is Bet Shean – here the bodies of Saul and his sons were tied to the city walls. We continue and drive to Jericho* - the city destroyed by Joshua. Here you'll visit Elijah's fountain where he allowed the axe to float and sweetened the water. View the mount of Temptation. We stop to visit the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Our journey continues to Ein Bokek where we will be transferred to our resort hotel on the shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. You also have the opportunity to swim (or rather float!) in the salty mineral water of the Dead Sea. Dinner and overnight in Ein Bokek.
- DAY 05 MON 22 OCT** **MASSADA – BETHANY – MODEL OLD CITY – JERUSALEM**
This morning after breakfast we depart from Ein Bokek and drive to Mount Massada. On arrival we ascent Mount Massada by way of cable car. On top of the mountain you'll see the ruins of a Jewish Fortress where 967 Jews committed mass-suicide rather than surrender to their Roman besiegers. Hereafter we depart and drive to Bethany where you'll visit the Tomb of Lazarus. We also visit the Holyland Model, a giant scale model of Jerusalem at the time of Jesus. Hereafter we will drive to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 06 TUES 23 OCT** **FULL DAY OLD CITY – JERUSALEM**
After breakfast you will enter the Old City through the Dung Gate and walk to the Wailing Wall, also known as the Western Wall, holiest site for the Jews. Continue to the Temple Area* where you will view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock where Solomon's temple stood and the rock where Isaac according to tradition was to have been offered. Walk via the Oriental Market to the Damascus Gate. This afternoon you will re-enter the Old City through the St. Stephen's Gate, also known as the Lion Gate. You will stop for a visit to the pool of Bethesda, the Fortress of Antonio, and the Ecco Homo Arch. Follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the traditional Calvary with the Chapel where the crucifixion is said to have taken place. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

- DAY 07 WED 24 OCT** **NEW CITY – UPPER ROOM – ST PETER IN GALICANTU**
This morning after breakfast we visit the New City of Jerusalem. Our tour includes the Tomb of David, the Upper Room of the Last Supper. We visit the Cardo Area in the Old City Jewish Quarter. This afternoon we visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, also known as the House of Caiaphas or the "Church of the Cockcrow", where Peter denied Jesus. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 08 THURS 25 OCT** **BETHLEHEM* – MT OF OLIVES – GETSEMANE**
We enjoy breakfast, where after you will drive to Bethlehem* and visit the Basilica of Nativity built on the site of Jesus' birth. Enjoy the spectacular view over the Shepherd's fields. On our return to Jerusalem, we visit the Mount of Olives with its beautiful view over Jerusalem. We walk down the slopes of the Mt of Olives to Getsémané, and on route we visit the Dominus Flavit Church, with its beautiful view over the old city and the Golden Gate. Getsémané is where Jesus prayed, specially the night before his crucifixion (Luke 22:39). Judas also betrayed Him here, and this is the place where Peter cut off the ear of the high priest's servant (John 18:10). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 09 FRI 26 OCT** **JERUSALEM – BEN GURION / CAIRO**
This morning after breakfast you will be transferred to Ben Gurion Airport for your return flight to Cairo on Air Sinai flight 4D 043 departing Ben Gurion Airport at 12:00 and arriving Cairo 13:10. In Cairo you will be met and taken on a afternoon tour of the Egyptian Museum. The Egyptian Museum with its unique display of articles of the early antique times of Egypt and the spectacular treasures of King Tutankhamun. It is the world's biggest and best collection of Egypt antiques that represent 5 000 year's of history. Transfer to the Grand Pyramids hotel in Cairo for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 10 SAT 27 OCT** **CAIRO**
This morning after a leisurely breakfast we depart on our tour and visit one of the "THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE WORLD" – the large Pyramids and the Sphinx of Giza. It remains a charismatic figure, standing 22 meters high, representing a man with the body of a lion. We visit the Church of St Simeon the Tanner, on a ridge above 'Garbage City', is just a part of a whole complex carved into the cliffs. It seats 5000 and is ringed with biblical scenes carved into the rock. We also visit a Coptic church, and if time permitting we will visit the El Khalili market. In addition to shops, there are several coffeeshouses, restaurants, and street food vendors distributed throughout the market. Tonight our highlight is a dinner Nile cruise. At ±21:30 you will be transferred to Cairo airport for your return flight to South Africa.
- DAY 11 SUN 28 OCT** **CAIRO / JOHANNESBURG**
You depart on Egypt Air MS 839 at Arrive back at O.R. Tambo International Airport at ± ... am after a wonderful tour through Israel and Egypt with beautiful memories, an enriched spirit, and a large circle of new friends
